This picture book serves as a toddlerfriendly introduction to assistive communication devices, specifically physical cards, and demonstrates how they can be used in a variety of settings.



How does this differ from other books on the market?

Other books take time to explore signing in addition to AAC, Given the stigma often associated with it, this book focuses primarily on AAC in an effort to increase education and awareness.

Who can benefit from this book?

This book is intended for at-home use, but it can also be helpful for Speech Language Pathologists and Special Education teachers/coordinators.

Does my child need to be nonverbal to enjoy this book?

Nope. We encourage all children to enjoy this book. AAC devices are often given to nonspeaking students as young as preK or Kindergarten. This book can give speaking students a better understanding of their peers.
